Definitions, Polination and seed collection by:  
Gert Forum Petersen, Denmark Seed Chairman

Pollination: The transfer of the male pollen to the  
female stigma in order to obtain fertile seeds.

Siblings: Plants of the same parental origin.

Intra-Siblings: Cross among siblings.

Inter-Clonal: Cross between two different clones of  
the same species.

Selfed: Pollination with the flower's own pollen or  
pollen from another plant of the same clone. Many  
lepidote and some elipidote Rhododendrons are self-  
fertile, but in any case cross pollination of species  
produces more vigorous offsprings.

C.W.: Collected wild i.e. seeds harvested from wild  
plants at their natural habitat. The seeds coming true  
will mainly look like the mother, but hybrids can occur.

\*Besides the name of the species the geographic  
location and the altitude is important information

O.P.: Open pollination, the pollination has happened in  
the natural way by the aid of insects, birds, wind or  
self pollination, perhaps before the flower has opened.

Under garden conditions, where many species  
(separated in nature) grow close together, the  
majority of the open pollinated seeds will be hybrids  
with unknown father(s) and the value of the offspring  
will be unpredictable. The species which are known not  
to hybridize: R. albiflorum, R. camtschaticum, R.  
vaseyi, R. schlippenbachii, R. semibarbatum.

H.P.: Hand pollination, emasculation, i.e. the removal  
of the corolla and stamens from the unopened flower,  
leaves the style with the untouched stigma unattractive  
to insects, with remarkable decrease in the risk for  
unwanted pollination, without totally eliminating the  
risk of it. The pollination is carried out "by hand" by  
placing pollen from the selected father on the stigma.  
No effort is made to protect the stigma either before or  
after the pollination, but at least the nearby flowers  
should be removed.

C.P.: Control pollination gives you full control over  
the entire pollination process: The clean stigma from  
the unopened flower is pollinated as for H.P. and the  
stigma is then protected against unwanted pollen with  
micropore tape or easier by means of a little aluminum  
foil tube. If the stigma is not ready (shining and sticky)  
for receiving the pollen (particularly important when  
using frozen pollen), the stigma must be protected until  
ready; best of all with an aluminum foil tube which can  
easily be removed without harming the stigma. With  
C.P. it is often unnecessary to remove corolla and  
stamens. The omission of this process lowers the risk  
of self pollination.
